Dear Beloved of Trinity,

The season of Lent begins early this year and happens to fall on Valentine's Day, February 14. It continues for 40 days, excluding Sundays. The 40 days of Lent is based on Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the wilderness.

Lent began as a time of preparation for those who would be baptized on Easter Eve. Through the years, it became a time for all Christians to examine their lives, strengthen their faith and make an emphasis on confession of sins as we prepare for Easter. On Ash Wednesday, will have the imposition of ashes symbolizing that our bodies will someday return to the dust of the earth. Bring your family to this service as we begin our walk through Lent together.

This week in scripture we continue in the first chapter of Mark as Jesus begins his public ministry.
