Dear friends in Christ,

At the Sunday morning adult Bible study, we have begun reading through the book of Exodus. (By the way, you're always welcome to join. We meet from 9:15 until about 10:15 each Sunday in the Connections Room. The discussions are always interesting.) So far, we've read about Moses as a baby rescued from the Nile to the revelation of his calling to lead the Israelites out of Egyptian slavery. We haven't started into the forty years in the wilderness, but as we prepare for the 40 days of Lent, I've been wondering about their wanderings.

During the 40 years of wandering in the wilderness, we are taught that God was with the people in the tabernacle that housed the Arc of the Covenant. As the people moved from place to place, God was directly in their midst. The number forty reappears immediately after Jesus is baptized and the Holy Spirit drives him into the wilderness for forty days. The gospel of Mark gives the most succinct description of what happened during those days. According to Mark, Jesus was tempted by Satan, was with the wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him Yet, even as Jesus experienced the trying times of temptation, he never was alone. God, the Father, was present.

This Ash Wednesday we will gather with an invitation to intentionally enter the spiritual disciplines of Lent. We will hear these words, "As disciples of Jesus, we are called to a discipline that contends against evil and resists whatever leads us away from love of God and neighbor. I invite you, therefore, to the discipline of Lent – self-examination and repentance, prayer and fasting, sacrificial giving and works of love – strengthened by the gifts of word and sacrament."

As each of us enters our own forty-day journey, remember that God is with you, just as God was with the Israelites and with Jesus in the wilderness.
