Dear friends in Christ,

Last week our Tuesday morning Men's Breakfast group read the following passage from Joel 2:

Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of the LORD is coming, it is near...a day of clouds and thick darkness.

Being good Midwesterners, we quickly began talking about the weather. "Sound the alarm!" We spoke about the old storm sirens that in the days before pagers and electronic communication sent the firefighters running to their trucks. "A day of clouds and thick darkness!" We remembered where we were when the derecho wall storm walked across the prairie and turned daylight to night. We talked about near misses with tornados and skies that turned green. Midwesterners are familiar with alarms, sirens, and storms.

We also talked about the odd desire to stand on the front porch and watch the tornado come even when we know that fleeing to the basement is the wiser choice. People sometimes have odd responses to storms.

Joel uses this storm imagery as a reminder that our rebellious and sinful nature can destroy our personal and communal worlds much like a tornado can tear a neighborhood to shreds. God calls us to turn away from selfishness and toward the loving and just ways of living that resonate with the kingdom of God. The alarm is God's warning to step back from danger.

As we continue our journey through the season of Lent, we are invited to listen to the warning about the damage our self-destructive ways harm ourselves, our neighbors, and the world. Sometimes we need to be reminded to take the storm warning seriously.

Family meal begins at 5:15 pm. You do not have to cook at all on Wednesday nights! Come enjoy a warm meal served until 6:15 pm.


