Dear Beloved of Trinity,

In Kyle Idleman's book, Not A Fan, he describes two types of Christians: one who is committed to follow Jesus and one who is just a fan of Jesus. A fan is an "enthusiastic admirer". A fan is someone who loves his favorite team. He knows stats about every player; they display bumper stickers on their cars and proudly wear jerseys. He cheers loudly in front of his tv but nothing is required of him. There is no commitment on his part. He is an enthusiastic admirer. He is a fan. A fan knows all about the team but doesn't really know the team.

In scripture this week, we will encounter a Pharisee by the name of Nicodemus. He used the religious ruler to measure his faith. He had studies hard as a youth; had passed many tests and moved up the ladder; was well respected in his hometown; followed all the rules to the point ad nauseam; he outwardly looked the part.

But Jesus knew his heart. Jesus knew that his heart wasn't in the right place. He was just a fan, not a fully committed follower.

This week in scripture we will hear the most quoted verse in the whole Bible. John 3:16, "for God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, that whoever believes in him, will not perish but have eternal life."

Nicodemus asks to meet with Jesus in the darkness of night. He didn't want to risk his reputation, yet he was curious and had so many questions. Jesus challenges Nicodemus and explains God's great love for him and for all the world. (Hence John 3:16)

I love the story of Nicodemus. He's a fascinating Biblical character. He's well educated yet learned a huge lesson and was able to make a 180-degree change in his life, to go from fan to fully committed believer.

We learn from Jesus as he uses ordinary and extra ordinary people throughout millennia. I think he's using you and it's pretty awesome.




