Dear Beloved of Trinity,

I don't know about you, but Lent seemed to fly by. And Holy Week and Easter are fast approaching. I have always loved Holy Week. For a minister, it is probably the busiest time of the year, with the added services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and 3 services on Easter morning. There is a lot of worship planning involved with Palm Sunday and Holy Week, telling the story of Jesus' last week on earth.

Typically, in worship, this Sunday's scripture readings would be all about Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem or Palm Sunday as we usually call it. But over the years, it was realized that many parishioners did not attend Maundy Thursday service to hear the story of the last supper, Jesus' instruction to his disciples to serve others, Judas' betrayal of Jesus, the mock trial and Peter's denial. Nor did parishioners attend Good Friday service to hear the story of Jesus' trial, suffering and death. So they would leave on Palm Sunday hearing shouts of "Hosanna" then return the following Sunday hearing shouts of "He is rise!" without the huge story in between.

To help fill in the blanks, the church includes the passion story with the palm story. So this Sunday we will begin with a lively processional with palm branches singing, "All Glory, Laud and Honor". Then as the service continues, move into the story of betrayal and death. We end the service with our older Sunday School children signing "I Can Only Imagine". It is very moving.

Palm branches are an important symbol for this Sunday. In the first century, they would have waved palm branches for victorious warriors returning from war or kings or princes returning to their city. The donkey Jesus rode on symbolizes his role as servant king. Other kings rode in on horses.

There are many symbols displayed throughout the week; a kingly crown and a crown of thorns to symbolize Jesus' dual role as the King of Kings and the suffering King as well. Walk with us this week as we walk with Jesus. May your week be holy.


