Dear friends in Christ,

Many years ago, I read a pastor's newsletter article about gratitude that I have never forgotten. If I remember the article correctly, the pastor was working in a large congregation in the Twin Cities that had a maintenance person on staff who had an interesting response to the common greeting, "How are you today?" Instead of responding with the customary "fine, pretty good, or fair to partly cloudy," the coworker had a one word reply every time.

"How are you?"
"Grateful."

What a meaningful and wonderful response!

If a person were to list spiritual qualities that can fundamentally change a person's day to day life, cultivating a personal habit of gratitude would be near the top. So often we take things for granted. About ten years ago, I had major back surgery that included a six-day hospital stay. I vividly remember day two when the physical therapist helped me sit up on the side of the bed and started to coach me through the ten steps to the bathroom. Sitting on the edge of that bed those ten steps ahead of me looked like ten miles. Of course, it didn't take me long to start taking standing up and walking for granted, but occasionally, I pause before that first step of the day and say a simple but heartfelt prayer. "Thank you!"

Recently a member of the Board of Stewardship saw a thank you card that had the simple phrase, "Beyond Grateful" printed on the front. That card started a conversation with the Board members to invite the congregation to spend the next several months cultivating the spiritual practice of gratitude. A few suggestions. Each morning say a simple prayer of gratitude for the new day. Write a note to a family member or friend to let them know how much you appreciate them. If you have young children in your home, speak aloud your gratitude for the beautiful day or the light bulb that comes on when you flick the switch so your children can learn about gratitude. Personally, I've made

a goal to write ten greeting cards a week for the next couple of months to let people know that I am beyond grateful for them.

How are you? I'm grateful. Specifically, want you to know that I'm so grateful for the wonderful people of Trinity Lutheran Church in Tea, South Dakota.


